### **WEATHER:**

Average October temperature in Romania is **7-18°C / 44-64 F**.  
Monday might be rainy. Sinaia might be cold.

### **CLOTHING:**

- For **Monday 16<sup>st</sup>** October the participants should have comfortable shoes as you will have a walking guided tour of Bucharest in the morning
- For **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup>** October choose an outfit which works both for the meeting with the members of government as well as the trip to the country side in the afternoon.
- Nothing special on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup>** October

### **CURRENCY:**

1 EUR= 3,5 RON(New Lei)<=>35 000 ROL(old Lei) both units are commonly used  
1 USD= approx. 2,75 RON

Credit cards – Visa, MasterCard/Eurocard, American Express, Diner's Club - are widely accepted in most places.

### **TIME:**

In Romania it's one hour later than in Germany.  
Flight schedule considers local time.
